On the above date, at approximately 0500 hours, 1 Officer Latifah Banks along with Officer Precious Long began feeding for the unit. Offender Lisa Michelle Courtney #214106 did not get off her rack to receive her tray, her bunkmate Offender Krystle Harper #169260 received it for her. Offender Courtney #214106 was assigned to 458B but was laying on 458T. At approximately 0600 hours, 1 Officer Banks along with Officer Long began to pick up empty trays and pass out ice to all offenders. Offender Lisa Courtney #214106 stated that she needed assistance and that she was having difficulty breathing. 1 Officer Banks stated okay give me a minute and we, Officer Banks and Officer Long continued to pick up trays and pass out ice. 1, Officer Banks along with Officer Long continued on to B zone to collect trays and then to A zone. Upon entering A zone, at approximately 0608 hours, 1 Officer Banks escorted Lisa Jo Chamberlain #122376 to the shower for shower call. The last tray was picked up at approximately 0615 hours, that's when Offender Pamela Toney #183758 stated that offenders from C zone were screaming for assistance for someone to come check on Offender Lisa Courtney #214106. At approximately 0617 hours, Officer Banks entered C zone and was advised by Offender Krystle Harper #169260 that Offender Courtney #214106 fell off her rack and hit her head and that she was not moving. 1 Officer Banks then returned and opened cell long for assistance but she was already entering the zone. 1 Officer Banks then returned and opened cell #458 and advised Offender Harper #169260 to step outside the door. 1 Officer Banks then checked Offender Courtney #214106 for a pulse, she did not have one. Offender Harper #169260 was then advised to get dressed and sit in the dayroom area. At 0619 hours, 1 Officer Banks called 10-17 Medical over the radio. At 0620 hours, 1 Officers Banks called 720 clinic and advised Nurse Gray of the situation. At 0621 hours, 1 Officer Banks and Officer Long re-entered C zone and 1 Officer Banks began chest compressions on Offender Lisa Courtney #214106. At approximately 0626 hours, Officer My'Esha Summers entered unit. At approximately 0630 hours, Captain Denise Bone along with Nurse Yolanda Stubblefield and Nurse Gray
